Good housekeeping is a good way of preventing accidents on the job site. Poor housekeeping gives a bad impression on management and a lack of professionalism. Due to bad housekeeping, there is an increase in the possibility of having an accident.

- 4. Tools should be properly stored out of the way when not in use.
- 5. Dispose of all combustible materials properly.

Storage trailers must be free of clutter. Materials stored in the trailer cannot be found when they are needed.



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
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
